

Technology Integration Committee

The technology integration committee is in the process of meeting its four goals for the year.

1. Have 3-4 workshops that focus on the themes of the model curriculum and how technology can be used to support the IPA.
 - a. The Fall Technology Workshop was held at Kent State in early November – the workshop sold out.
 - b. The Technology Team is presenting a workshop at the annual OFLA conference.
 - c. Per request, I've added in a differentiated instruction workshop that connects technology, IPA, and instruction: two workshops were had in February & March (Twinsburg & Columbus) and one more will be in May in Toledo.
 - d. A few technology team members are presenting individually at the OFLA conference on various topics related to technology.
 - e. The tech team is planning on having at least one summer workshop as well.
2. Develop at tech-based IPA to reflect themes of the model curriculum.
 - a. The IPAs are hosted at <http://www.livebinders.com/play/play/1504217>.
 - b. Each tech team member completed at least one tech IPA by early December.
 - c. We received a request for a second round and have scheduled and started uploading these at the same site.
3. The tech committee added several new members this year.
 - a. Members were added with careful consideration to ensure that there was an equitable distribution based on location, level of instruction, and language.
4. Examine the policies and procedures of the OFLA Listserv
 - a. The OFLA Board approved a Netiquette policy for OFLA Listserv messages.
 - b. The Listserv moderators and Cheryl Johnson are in the process of exploring a different listserv system that will provide members with additional options.
5. Additional Information
 - a. The group thanks the OFLA Awards Committee for recognizing the hard work it has done this year and awarding the Outstanding Tech Award to the group.
 - b. The Tech Integration committee created the video for CCSTFL (2016). The team thanks Gabriela Linik for taking the reins on this.
 - c. I attended CSCTFL in Minneapolis as Ohio's representative for the extension workshop
